

Under the Health Protection (Coronavirus, Restrictions) (No.2) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2020, put in place by the NI Executive and which came into force on Friday 16 October 2020, the following named businesses have had to close, cease trading or be restricted.

1. Café;
2. Restaurant;
3. Hotel;
4. Guesthouse;
5. Registered bed & breakfast;
6. Pub;
7. Hairdressing or barbering;
8. Provision of beauty or aesthetics treatments including treatments in relation to nails or makeup;
9. Tattooing;
10. Tanning;
11. Services in spas;
12. Sports and massage therapy except if provided to an elite athlete;
13. Well-being and holistic therapies;
14. Dress fitting, tailoring and fashion design (unless social distance is maintained);
15. Body piercing;
16. Electrolysis;
17. Training in any of the close contact services listed (unless social distancing is maintained);
18. Businesses which organise sporting events (can only do so for elite athletes indoor and outdoor, one-to-one with coach/trainer indoor, individual and carer indoor, or if outdoor event and no more than 15 people);
19. Driving instruction for the test of competence to drive a vehicle other than a motorcycle established by Article 5 of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(3);
20. Campsites and caravan parks for touring caravans;
21. Museums and galleries;
22. Bingo halls;
23. Cinemas (but not cinemas at which visitors remain in a vehicle); and
24. Fairs (whether outdoors or indoors)
25. Inflatable parks;
26. Indoor amusement arcades;
27. Skating rinks;
28. Indoor visitor attractions;
29. A business of providing facilities for persons to consume intoxicating liquor in or on a conveyance;
30. Bowling alleys.

Note:

- Close contact services are not prohibited for the purpose of film or television production.
- Bed and breakfast establishments etc. and most businesses or members' clubs which sell or provide food or drink (including intoxicating liquor) for consumption on the premises are likely to be covered by the [Localised Restrictions Support Scheme](#), as are private libraries.
